# (Minutes of the December 19, 2019 meeting of the Chemung County Library District Board of Trustees. Document #2020-1)

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Marge Kappanadze. Present were Pat Silvernail, Ann Hayes, Pam Larnard, Martha Smith, Jack Schamel, Karl Schwesinger, Rachel Dworkin, Kevin Hansen, Jessica Roberts, Bonnie Chollet, Phyllis Rogan, and Lee Saginario, excused Lillian White. Absent was Tim Blandford. Also present were Holly Melott and Ron Shaw, the Library District's Administration, and twenty-two residents of Chemung County.

Mr. Schamel moved that the order of the agenda be changed to allow public expression first, seconded by Ms. Chollet. VOTE: Unanimously approved. Residents of Chemung County expressed their opinions on the recent "Frozen Drag Storytime" event that was held at the Steele Memorial Library.

**Minutes.** The minutes of the November 2019 meeting (Document #2019-67) were presented for board review. The minutes of the November meeting are approved as distributed by unanimous consent.

## **Report of the January 8, 2020 meeting of the Executive Committee of the Chemung County Library District:**

The meeting came to order at 6:00pm. Attending the meeting from the Executive Committee were Jack Schamel, Phyllis Rogan and Martha Smith and Holly Melott and Ronald Shaw, CCLD management. Other board members in attendance were Pat Silvernail, Karl Schwesinger, Bonnie Chollet, Ann Hayes, Jessica Roberts, Rachel Dworkin, Kevin Hansen, Lee Saginario, and Pam Larnard.

Ms. Rogan called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

UNPAID BILLS: Ms. Melott submitted the Unpaid Bill List dated 12/31/2019 for the General Fund - \$12,563.75 and the Grant Fund - \$4048.53, dated 1/8/2020 for the General Fund - \$83,856.65. Ms. Dworkin moved, seconded by Mr. Schamel to approve payment of the bills as submitted in writing. VOTE: Unanimously Approved.

Director Ron Shaw gave the following reports:

Mr. Shaw stated that staff are requesting that a security guard be hired to have on the premises during hours of operation. Mr. Shaw has instructed staff to uphold and maintain the established Library Code of Conduct. There have been no formal complaints or incidents reported at this time.

A strict "No Food Policy" has been enacted at Steele due to numerous occasions that patrons were leaving food throughout the building.

Members of the Labor Management Committee have requested that an amendment be added to the current contract, which would allow employees who retire after 10 years of library service, be granted paid health insurance coverage. Mr. Schamel made a recommendation be sent to the board, not to entertain this proposal.

The Friends group will be giving \$18,000 for library programming in 2020. Monies will be distributed. Supervisors are considering, not holding a district wide Summer Reading party this year. Branches will have adequate funding to host their own celebrations.
